- 3. A deployed, deceased, POW or MIA U.S. military member, or
- 4. An active duty international military member currently assigned to Wright-Patterson AFB.

QUALIFICATIONS

The applicant must meet **ALL** of the following qualifications:

- 1. Currently attend a public, private, or home school and will graduate high school in the 2016-2017 academic year. (Spouses exempt.)
- 2. Currently hold an unweighted cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- 3. Have submitted applications and plan to enroll as a **full-time** student for the **2017-2018** school year at a college, university, or technical school accredited through an agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation.
- 4. Submit a complete application to the Scholarship Committee of the Wright-Patterson Officers' Spouses' Club.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Completed applications must be postmarked by March 8, 2017. The WPOSC and the members of the Scholarship Committee are not responsible for lost or misdirected applications.
- 2. Incomplete applications, or those postmarked after the deadline, will not be accepted.
- 3. No WPOSC member or family member may serve as a judge on the Scholarship Selection Panel.
- 4. Scholarship recipients will be notified in April 2017.
