



WPOSC GIVING BACK

The welfare committee has been busy since our last update in September and would like to catch you up on the wonderful organizations that your

WPOSC has been supporting!

Giving back for the Holidays: We supported the efforts of the Air Force Sergeants Association with a donation towards their holiday gift card program which provides \$50 commissary gift cards to Airmen in need at Thanksgiving. Although funding for Holiday parties was limited, we donated towards holiday celebrations for the 88 Force Support Squadron and NASIC WMX Squadron, benefitting approximately 800 members across the squadrons. Regarding these holiday celebrations, we received photos and a letter of appreciation from one of the commanders stating-"Your organization's commitment to supporting Airmen is valued and appreciated beyond words."

Other military organizations which have received

Air Force Villages received funding which will be used to provide confidential monthly charitable assistance to retired Air Force officers' surviving spouses who have made Blue Skies of Texas their home, and who would be unable to continue as residents without this assistance. The assistance can include daily living expenses and cover medical costs. Our contact from this organization thanked us for our continued support towards this cause and sent us the following statement from a recipient of the Air Force Widow's Fund: "Shortly after we moved here (to Blue Skies of Texas), my husband became ill. Now, the Air Force Widow's Fund allows me as a widow to remain here and to live within my means. I don't have any other place to go, and I don't know where I would go if I had to move."







Other military organizations which have received funding from the WPOSC include:

Wright Patterson Top 3 for their Annual Awards Banquet held in February 2024 which recognized Airmen at WPAFB for their outstanding work last year.

Organizations in the Miami Valley Community which have received funding include:

Hannah's Treasure Chest was chosen as our December Function charity. It is is a nonprofit organization which enriches the lives of children in need by providing care packages of clothes, shoes, books, safety equipment and hygiene items including diapers through a network of 75 partners throughout southwest Ohio.

Ohio's Hospice of Dayton received funds for their Pathways of Hope Program. This program provides comprehensive bereavement services and resources to individuals, families, and organizations impacted by significant loss due to death. The program is offered completely free of charge regardless of affiliation to Ohio's Hospice of Dayton to anyone in the community who needs grief counseling.



WHAT'S COOKIN'?

Homemade Recipe for Granola Cereal (And Bars!)

• "100 Days of Real Food"

- 3 1/2 cups oats (rolled, (if you want bars use steel cut oats so it will stick together better))
- 1 cup almonds (raw, sliced)
- 1 cup cashews (or walnuts or pecans)
- 1 cup unsweetened coconut flakes
- 1/2 cup sunflower seeds (raw)
- 1/2 cup pumpkin seeds (raw)
- 2 teaspoons cinnamon (ground)
- 11/2 teaspoons ginger (ground)
- 1/2 teaspoon nutmeg (ground)
- 6 tablespoons butter (unsalted)
- 1/2 cup honey
- 2 teaspoons pure vanilla extract
- 1/2 teaspoon salt



- Preheat the oven to 250 degrees. Cover a rectangular baking sheet with parchment paper.
- Mix the dry oats, almonds, cashews, coconut, seeds and spices together in a large mixing bowl.
- Heat the butter and honey together in a small saucepan over low heat. Once the butter melts stir in the vanilla and salt.
- Pour the hot liquids over the dry ingredients and stir together with a rubber spatula until evenly coated.
- Spread mixture onto prepared pan in one even layer. Bake for 75 minutes.
- The granola will become crisp as it cools at which point you can break into pieces (if
 making bars) or break it up into small chunks by pounding it in a zip lock bag (if making
 cereal). Store in air tight container at room temperature for up to 2 weeks.
