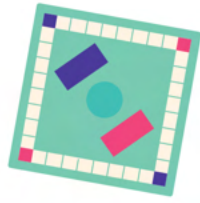

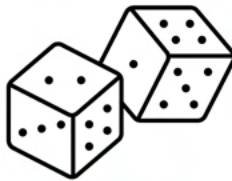
Game Night is off to a great start this year with familiar and new faces coming to play!



Book Club had a great turnout to discuss September's book!



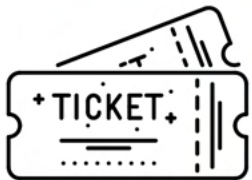
Bunco was small but exciting as we kick off football season!
