## Wright-Patterson Officers' Spouses' Club (WPOSC) Scholarships for Military Dependents 2025 Eligibility Guidelines From WPOSC Board of Governors Policies and Procedures Appendix 5.11.12

## 5.11.12 Eligibility

- 5.11.12.1 Applicants will be a dependent child or spouse of an active duty, retired, deceased, prisoner of war (POW) or missing in action (MIA) U.S. Armed Forces or Reserve Component (RC) member residing within 100 miles or who is affiliated with Wright Patterson Air Force Base (WPAFB) (affiliation may be sponsors work); or an active duty international military dependent currently assigned to WPAFB and residing within 100 miles of WPAFB; and
- 5.11.12.2 Applicants will be full-time undergraduate or graduate student at an accredited college, university or technical school during the following academic year (fall and/or spring term) with at least one full-time semester/quarter of credit hours remaining before graduation.
- 5.11.12.3 Applicants must have a minimum unweighted grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- 5.11.12.4 Applicants must meet eligibility in one of three available categories:
  - 5.11.12.4.1 High School Senior category will be a graduating student, not a spouse, within the current school/award year from an accredited public, private or home high school; or
  - 5.11.12.4.2 Spouse category will be an undergraduate or graduate spouse at least one full-time semester/quarter of credit hours remaining before graduation; or
  - 5.11.12.4.3 Dependent non-spouse category will be a current undergraduate or graduate with at least one full-time semester/quarter of credit hours remaining before graduation and not eligible in another category.

## 5.11.13 Applicants ineligible to receive WPOSC scholarships:

- 5.11.13.1 Recipients of "full funding" (e.g., tuition, fees, books, and room and board) from another source, excluding private and financial aid loans.
- 5.11.13.2 Recipients of a U.S. service academy appointment.
- 5.11.13.3 Individuals previously awarded or selected to receive a WPOSC scholarship.

## 5.11.14 Applications

- 5.11.14.1 Applications must be submitted electronically to the scholarship chair.
- 5.11.14.2 Applications must be submitted in PDF format.
- 5.11.14.3 Applications must be received no later than 11:59 PM Eastern Time (EST) on the published deadline.
- 5.11.14.4 Official transcripts and letter of recommendations must be received either from the applicant or third-party source (high school guidance office, university registrar, or recommender) by 11:59 PM EST on the published deadline.
- 5.11.14.5 Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 5.11.14.6 Applications submitted by individuals previously awarded or selected to receive a WPOSC scholarship in a prior academic year will not be considered.
- 5.11.14.7 Applicants will receive notification of non-selection.
